Information for Applicants

- 1. The applicant must be an active member of McGill Baptist Church.
- 2. The applicant must have been accepted by the school he or she plans to attend.
- 3. Criteria for selection will include scholastic achievement; financial need; service to school, church and community; character; and completeness of application.
- 4. A student applying for or re-applying for a scholarship during each of his or her years in school will be considered along with any other applicants. A grade average of C or better must have been maintained during the previous year to qualify for a scholarship. A transcript from the college of your grades should be provided to the committee.
- 5. If a student applied for but was not awarded a scholarship the previous year, he or she is invited to re-apply.
- 6. Application forms may be obtained in the church office and must be returned to the church office no later than the deadline published above and in The Way.
- 7. The Scholarship Committee of McGill Baptist Church will review applications, select the recipients, and present the scholarships at Graduates Recognition Day.
- 8. Applicants do not apply for a specific scholarship; the Scholarship Committee is responsible for awarding the individual scholarships.
